Laye Tops the Steer Wrestling Field at the 101st Falkland Stampede

It was a good weekend for Consort, Alberta steer wrestler, Brendan Laye. The 2018 PRCA Rookie of the year (he won the Canadian edition of that honour in 2016), dogged his steer in 4.0 seconds to earn the win at the 101st Falkland Stampede and take home \$1513.

"I love going to that rodeo," Laye commented. "It's such a great event so getting the win there is pretty cool. I rode Joe Guze's horse and had a really good steer and it all worked out."

That win coupled with a 4/5 split in the first round at Redding, California and a fourth place cheque at Hayward, CA made for a profitable weekend for the 3rd generation talent.

"We wanted to rest Tyson (Curtis Cassidy's SW Horse of the year) this week. And we took my horse down south; it was nice to win some on him too."

Laye is getting hot at just the right time as the Canadian rodeo schedule gets hectic in the coming weeks. "It's exciting. This is a confidence booster for sure and it makes a guy feel like you can have some luck on both sides of the border."

- Speaking of hot, saddle bronc rider, **Jake Watson** is burning it up everywhere he goes these days. The Hudson's Hope, BC cowboy made it four wins in two weeks as he rode Northcott-Macza's Honey Moon to 84 points and \$1264 and was 88 points for a \$4315 win at Redding.
- And **Jake Vold** was... well, Jake Vold. The three-time Canadian Bareback Riding Champion teamed up with Northcott-Macza's Stevie Knicks for a spectacular 92 points (which set a new Falkland Stampede arena record) good for \$1226.70.
- Three way split in the team roping with **Jeremy Buhler/Kolton Schmidt, Tyce McLeod/Tuftin McLeod and Keely Bonnett/Logan Bonnett** all in at 6.0 seconds which netted each roper \$936.24
- Josh Frost (Randlett, Utah) rode Northcott-Macza's 333 Orange Crush to win the bull riding event -\$1303.03
- Texan, Miranda Emmert 16.537 seconds for the ladies barrel racing win and \$1500.24
- Tie-down roping Clayton Smith, 8.4 seconds \$1621.50
- Novice bareback Chett Deitz, 75 points \$225.04
- Novice saddle bronc Hayden Cole 75 points \$256.08
- Junior steer riding **Dusty Golden**, 75 points \$289.06
