 - a. It is approved in writing by the Canadian Professional Rodeo Association and each party has received notice of such approval.
 - b. The Stock Contractor is a member in good standing of the Canadian Professional Rodeo Association, and
 - c. The Rodeo Committee complies with all By-laws and Rules of the Canadian Professional Rodeo Association.
3. ***The Rodeo Committee must have a minimum of \$2,000,000 public liability insurance and the C.P.R.A. and P.R.C.A., if co-sanctioned, must be named as an additional named insured.***

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TELEVISION OR FILMING C.P.R.A. EVENTS

**** The Canadian Professional Rodeo Association shall have and retains all rights** in and to the filming, taping, radio, internet or television broadcasting or reproduction in any manner or form of any of its approved events or any part thereof, which rights are hereby granted to the CPRA.

All proposals for filming, taping, radio, internet or television broadcasting or reproduction in any manner or form of sanctioned events, including local, cable, internet or educational television by any person nor specifically authorized by CPRA (including any member of CPRA) **must be cleared through the Airdrie office of the CPRA thirty (30) days prior to** the first performance of the specific rodeo.

Legitimate news or sports coverage by a recognized public news or sports network or station is exempted.

LIABILITY INSURANCE

*ALL CPRA rodeo committees must carry a minimum of two million dollars (\$2 million) per occurrence of public liability insurance. Proof of insurance, naming the Canadian Professional Rodeo Association as an additional insured, must be submitted to the CPRA as soon as possible, but not less than sixty (60) days prior to the first performance of the rodeo. For rodeos that are also sanctioned by the PRCA., the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association, must also be listed as an additional named insured. **Please initial if you understand.***
