1. CRES local line (eastern provinces call collect): (403) 945-0368
2. Western provinces & U.S.A. toll free: 1-800-661-8523
3. CRES administration: (403) 945-0358
4. CRES will be open from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm MT on entry and callback days unless otherwise listed. Ask operator for callback days and hours when entering. A rate of \$10 per contestant will be charged. All entrants must hold a current CPRA membership at the time the entry is made.
5. Two (2) day entries are from 8:00am to 2:00pm MT the first day and 8:00am to 11:00am MT on the second day.
6. Where PERMITS MAXIMUM is listed, entries may be limited, in which case a draw will be made by CRES to determine permit holders who will compete.
7. Contestant grace period will be from 2:30 pm to 3:30 pm MT for one day entries and 11:30 pm to 12:30 pm for two day entries unless otherwise advised at entry time. Contestants can only change their preferences at this time.

TURN OUT & MEDICAL RELEASE INFORMATION

1. All turnouts must be done by calling the Turn Out Line at (403) 945-7381 after CRES callback time
2. Turn outs must be done three (3) hours prior to the scheduled performance or slack time the contestant is scheduled to compete at. All turn out times are mountain time (MT), regardless of time zone rodeo is being held in.
3. When calling the turnout line, please include the following information, in this order: name, card number, event(s), name of rodeo(s), performance number(s) and if it is straight turn out, visible injury, 5 or 30 day vet release or a 10 or 30 day doctor release.
4. In the case of a release less than three (3) hours prior to the scheduled performance, it is still the responsibility of the contestant to notify the arena secretary.
5. All unofficals must be done through PROCOM.

MEMBERSHIPS OR PERMITS MUST BE PROCESSED TWO (2) BUSINESS DAYS BEFORE ENTRIES OPEN.

1. Top sixteen (16) point earners from each of the six major events that enter, plus the top sixteen (16) team roping headers and the top sixteen (16) team roping heelers that enter

from the 2010 CPRA approved rodeos with \$8,000 minimum added per event (Wrangler Canadian Rodeo Tour Rodeos, Tier A) as of August 16, 2010, along with the top four (4) point earners that enter from the remaining 2010 CPRA approved rodeos (Last Chance Tour, Tier B) as of August 23, 2010. If any of the top four (4) point earners from Tier B have already qualified through Tier A, the next contestant(s) from Tier B standings will qualify.

2. Contestants will enter through the CRES office on Thursday, August 26, 8:00 am - 2:00 pm MDT. All qualified contestants must confirm their entry at this time. Contestants not confirming at this time will be fined \$200 but allowed to compete. Contestant list will be finalized at 4pm MDT Friday, August 27, 2010. Contestants turning out/doctor release/vet release after Friday, August 27, 2010 will be replaced before the start of the first go-round in Pool A or B.

3. - **Pool A contestants:** Eight (8) contestants in the six (6) major event from the Wrangler Canadian Rodeo Tour Standings as of August 16, 2010. Contestants 1-3-5-7-9-11-13-15. As well as two (2) contestants from the Last Chance Tour. Contestants 1 & 3.

- **Pool B contestants:** Will be the remainder of those entered.

- Team roping qualifiers will select their partner. When partner selection is finalized the points earned by combining the header and heeler points together will determine the team's position in the standings for designation to Pool A or B as outlined above.

4. If a tie exists for entry into the Tour Championship, the tied contestant with the most money won in the 2010 CPRA regular season standings will advance to the Tour Championship. If a tie still exists the tied contestant with the most money won at Wrangler Canadian Rodeo Tour rodeos will advance. If a tie still exists the tied contestant with the most money won at Last Chance Tour locations will advance. If a tie still exists a draw will be made by the CRES staff to determine the finalist.

5. Once stock is drawn for go round one of Pool A or Pool B and a contestant withdraws, the next eligible contestant will replace that contestant on the stock drawn for the original contestant.

FORMAT

Day 1 and Day 2

- POOL A competes. The top 4 money earners over day 1 & 2 will advance to the Finals. If a tie exists for any position to advance, the tied contestant with the highest score / fastest time on two head will break the tie and advance. If a tie still exists, the tied contestant with the highest score/fastest time on day 1 or 2 will advance. If a tie still exists the 2010 CPRA regular season standings will break the tie.

Day 3 and Day 4

- Pool B Competes as above

Day 5 Finals

- Top four (4) from each pool advance for a total of eight (8) in the finals. If there is a turnout/doctor release/vet release in the finals the tie breaker to determine the replacement contestant will be the same as to advance to the finals from either pool A or B. No points or scores will be brought forward into the finals. Contestants will compete on one (1) head to determine the champion. If tied after one (1) head co-champions will be declared. Top two (2) contestants at the end of the Wrangler Canadian Rodeo Tour Final will receive a bye into the 2011 Calgary Stampede. In the case of a tie for the second Calgary Stampede position, the position will go to the contestant HIGHEST in the CPRA Official Standings as of September 6 2010
